### SCHEDULE

Parents will need to sign off on any changes that occur **BEFORE** the student is permitted to drop the old class and be admitted into a new class.

**PARTICIPATION FEE FOR STUDENTS IN MIDDLE AND HIGH SCHOOL SPORTS**

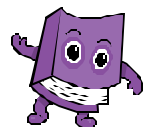
In order to maintain a quality program and continue to offer to students the same number of sports programs as in years past, Cedarville's Athletic Department has instituted a participation fee of \$75.00 for all sports and athletes in middle school and high school. Students must pay this fee to the coach or athletic department **by the first day of practice**. Students will not be permitted to participate in practice and/or competitions until the fee has been paid in its entirety.

Any student that pays for two seasons in one school year can play the third season for free. Refunds will only be given to athletes that are cut from the team after the try-out period. ***If a player quits, becomes ineligible, is removed from the team or does not complete the season, that student forfeits the participation fee.***
